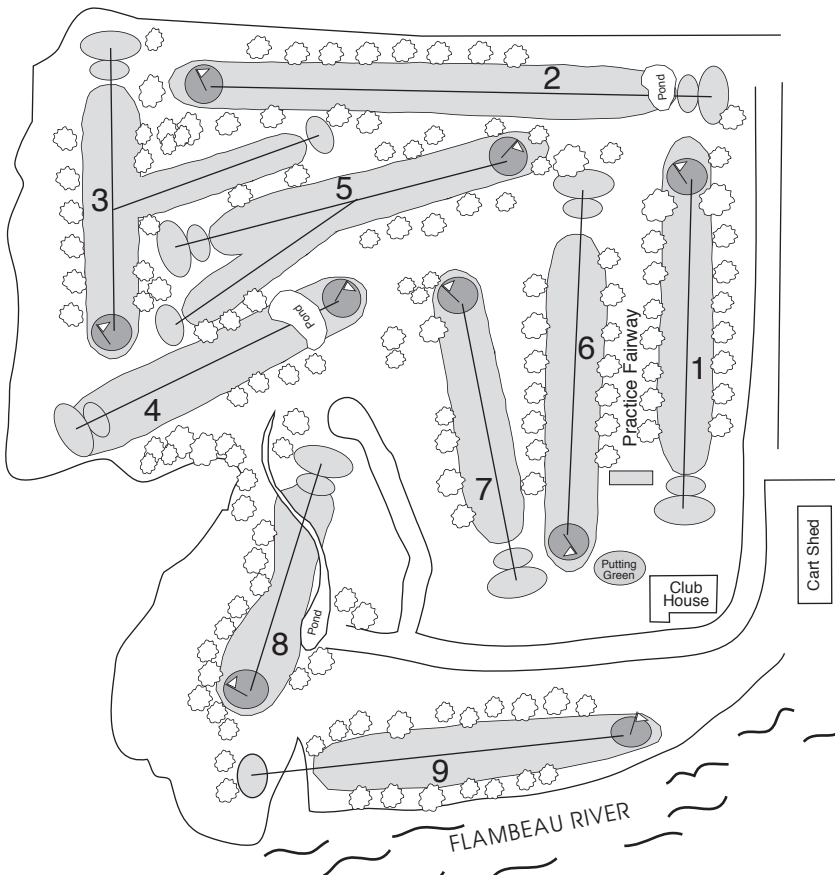
Out of Bounds:

- Road surface on 1
- White stakes on 2, 3, 4, 8
- Lateral water Hazard - Red Stakes on 7, 8, 9
- Water Hazard - Yellow Stakes on 4

Fairway Markers:

- Blue - 200 Yards
- White - 150 Yards
- Red - 100 Yards

Course Rules

Carts - Must stay at least 30 feet from tees and greens. Do *not* drive up on elevations surrounding tees and greens. You must be 16 to drive a cart. No more than 2 persons per cart.

NO Carry On Beverages Permitted

According to the state administrative code, all carry on beverages **must** be purchased from the club house. Violators may be asked to leave without a refund. We carry a wide assortment of alcoholic and non-alcoholic products that you may take on the golf course. Please help us by not bringing your own beverages.

1. All golfers and spectators must register in club house prior to round.
2. No practice swings on tees.
3. Replace divots.
4. Repair ball marks on greens.
5. Slower players let faster players play through.
6. Try to keep up with the group ahead of you.
7. Please put all garbage in trash containers.
8. No more than 4 players per group.
9. No ball hawking from ponds.
10. All players must wear shirts.
